As you are aware, we will be departing for the silver practice expedition On Friday 26th April. Below are a few key details regarding the expedition.

Timings:

- We will be aiming to depart from St Bede's College around 8:45am Friday morning, from the sports entrance car park.
- We will arrive back to the same entrance on Sunday 28th April around 2pm. If there is any delay in our expected arrival time, I will ask students to send messages home.

Equipment:

- Students have been briefed on the necessary equipment that is needed. Ultimately, waterproofs, rucksack, walking boots and warm clothing for the evening is vital. Please encourage your son/daughter not to over pack!
- If walking boots are new, please ensure they are worn in before the walk to avoid blisters.

Location:

- Both expeditions this year will take place in the Forest of Dean region. Beginning in woodland just north of Tintern, and ending at Tidenham Chase carpark, off the B4228.
- The campsite for Friday night will be Bracelands, near Symonds Yat.
- Saturday night we will be staying at Biblins youth campsite.

Communication:

- Garri (our DoE provider) and I will have mobile phones on us at all times. Students will be issued with these numbers in case of emergency.
- Please contact the school directly in case of an urgent message.
- For the assessed expedition, students will only be allowed a maximum of one phone per group, only to be used in an emergency. I can collect any phones in and keep them safe with staff valuables on the mini bus.

Medical information:

- A brief medical form is attached to this letter. If there have been any changes to medical information since registering for the DofE, please could this be updated.
- If any students are taking medication which is self-administered, please ensure this is clearly mentioned on the form.
- Students have been informed of what to do in case of a medical emergency. All staff on the expedition are outdoor first aid trained.
