Kevin Owen – RT International



Kevin Owen is a television and radio news anchor, reporter and presenter and has worked in UK regional and network broadcasting for more than thirty years. He is now based in Moscow for Russian global news channel RT, where he is the longest serving news anchor.

He started his career in this part of the world back in the late 1980's – and he's come back now, virtually, to say 'hi' to you.

Following a post-graduate diploma in broadcast Journalism from Cardiff University, early in his career Kevin presented the BBC Wales news programme 'Wales Today' from Cardiff in addition to the Saturday morning Breakfast Show on Radio Wales.

He then moved to the 'opposition' - HTV Wales to present 'Wales Tonight' before then coming over to sister channel HTV West and 'The West Tonight' for our part of the UK. It was from the studios now called 'Here!' on Bath Road and it's the ITV channel that's now called ITV West Country.

Kevin was bringing your parents their nightly news at 6pm here way back in the 1990's. He also had his own radio show at Orchard FM in Somerset – the station that's now become 'Heart Somerset'.

He left this part of the world in 2002 and went on to work for a host of national and global broadcasters including Sky News and the BBC World Service. For the last fifteen years Kevin has been the 'senior anchor' at the global English language news channel from Russia called RT.

In 2008 Kevin won Russia's TEFI award for 'News Anchor of the Year' becoming the first foreign national to win the award. It's similar to Britain's Royal Television Society Award and is an outstanding accolade and recognition for his work.

We are extremely grateful to Kevin for making time to say 'hello'.
