Dear Parent

Our Enrichment Week (Tuesday 16th to Friday 19th July) is nearly upon us, so I am writing to give you the final details. This of course is different for those on the residential activities trip. Here is the timetable for the week:

Please note that Monday 15th July will be Monday week B at St Bede's and that on Monday 22nd July, we return to normal lessons, week A.

Please also note that year 7 will be required to wear normal school uniform all week, except that on Friday only, when they should come ready dressed in their Sports Kit (tracksuit and trainers).

On Monday, and the days of the Enterprise Challenge/French Breakfast, Drama Workshops and the House day on Friday, they will eat their lunch in school; the canteen will be open as usual. For the trip to the Zoo the pupils should bring, in a suitable bag eg. knapsack, a packed lunch and plenty of water to drink, and have a shower proof coat, a hat, and have some sun cream either on or in a bottle ready to apply! Packed lunches have been ordered for children on free school meals on the day when they will be off-site.

If your child is on any medication, or needs to have an epi-pen or inhaler available, they should have it with them, and alert their staff trip leader if going off-site. Please note that any child who has not returned a parental consent form will not be allowed to participate in trips off-site.

It is absolutely vital that every effort is made for pupils to be punctual arriving at school. Pupils arriving late run the risk of being left behind as we cannot delay the departure of groups going out for the day.
