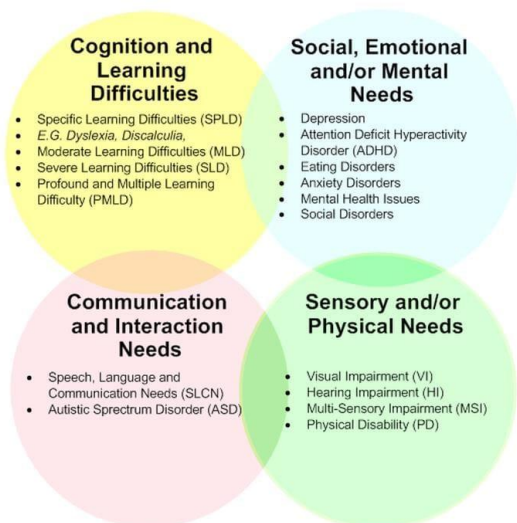
How are needs identified?

We follow a cycle of assess, plan, do and review. Student SEN profiles are stored on Bromcom.

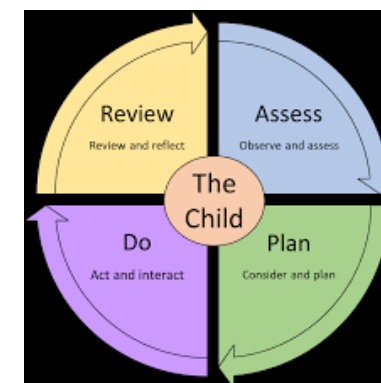
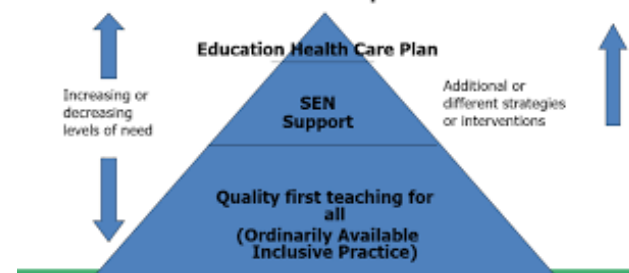
