



## Dedicated College Transport and other forms of Transport



Please talk through the following arrangements with your child before they use the college transport operated by Eurocoaches. These points have been established to keep children as safe as possible when travelling to and from the college. Any child who refuses to comply with the arrangements will face disciplinary action which may result in them being removed from the transport should their behaviour be deemed to be putting other travellers or themselves at risk of harm.

### **Waiting at the coach stop**

- Please maintain social distancing

### **Boarding the coach**

- A face covering must be worn at all times
- Use the hand sanitiser provided.
- Sit in the designated area for your year group. Year 7 at the front followed by Year 8 and so on.
- Seat belts to be worn at all times and therefore stay seated and facing forward.
- Follow instructions issued by the driver and/or coach prefect.

### **Arriving at College**

- Coaches will disembark one at a time so that children make their way to the sanitising station at the entrance to the college in a controlled and orderly fashion
- When removing a face covering, children must not touch the front of the covering but instead, place it into a plastic bag and put it inside their blazer pocket or bag for the journey home. If they are using a disposable covering, that should be placed in the designated bin at the sanitising station.

### **Departing the College**

- At the end of the college day, children will board the coaches in year group order organised by college staff.
