Amen.

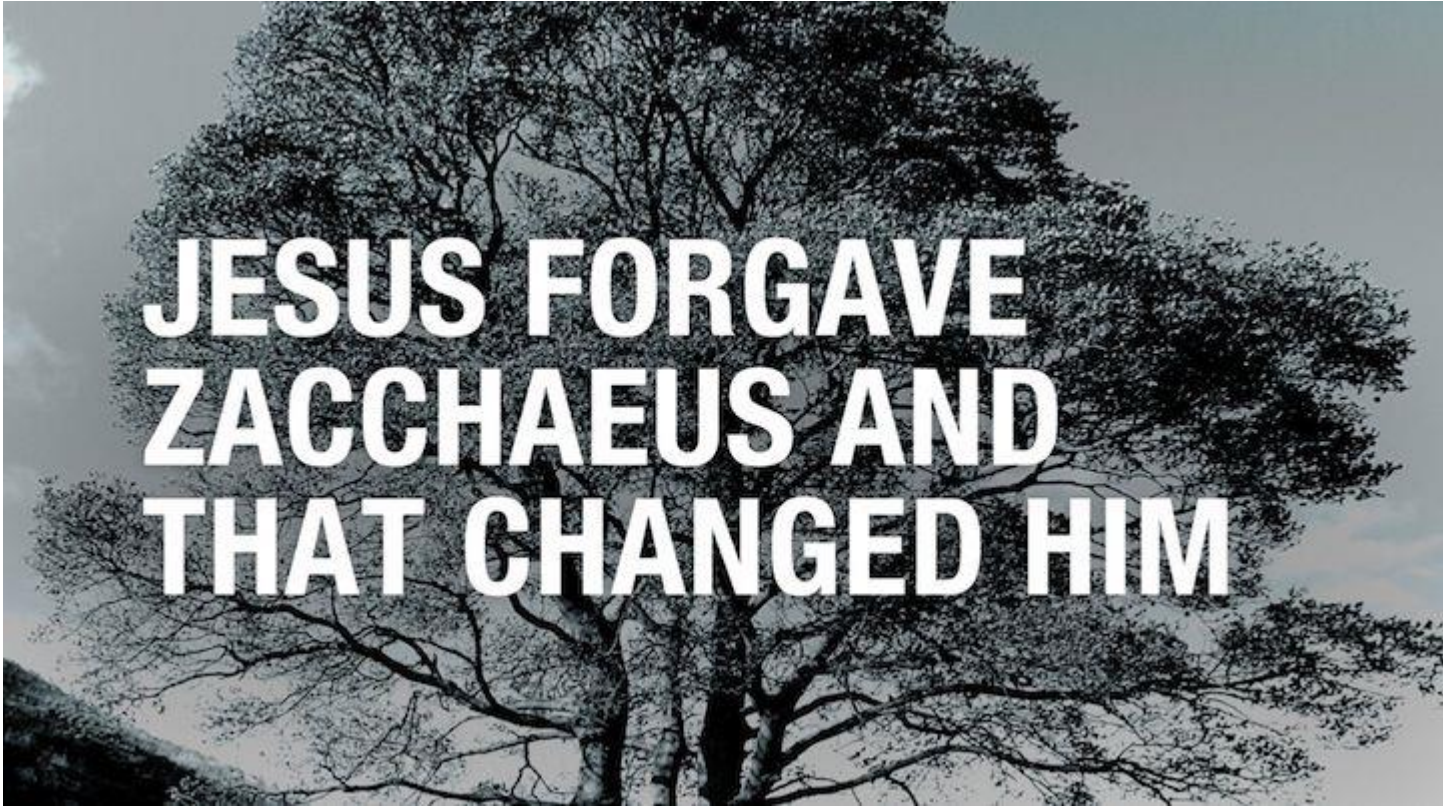


A reading from the Gospel of Luke
