Transport Arrangements 2022/23

In consultation with the three local authorities that we serve, transport arrangements have put in place which families are required to fund as follows;

Bristol: Four routes operate: Currently £49 per month, per child *

BRS01 Kings Drive, Kellaway Avenue, Golden Hill, Wellington Hill, Westbury Village
BRS02 Southmead Road, Doncaster Road, Greystoke Avenue/Brentry
BRS03 Eastgate, Muller Road, Horfield Common, Lake Road
BRS04 D04 Gloucester Road, Monks Park Avenue and Charlton Road

Please note : First Bus Public Bus Services operate number's 3 and 4 from Broadmead, Clifton, Stoke Bishop, Shirehampton, Avonmouth, Henbury and Cribbs Causeway.

South Gloucestershire: Three routes operate: Currently £57 per month per child *

SG01 Bromley Heath/Frenchay/Filton
SG02 Bradley Stoke/Little Stoke/Patchway/Severn Beach
SG03 Stoke Gifford/Bradley Stoke

North Somerset: Three routes operate: Currently £95 per month, per child *

WSM Route N Knightstone/ Milton / Worle
WSM Route S Corpus Christi / Drove Road
Route P Nailsea/ Clevedon/ Portishead

Is your child eligible for support with home to school transport?

Free Transport for all children travelling to denominational schools has been withdrawn by the three local authorities that we serve, Bristol, South Gloucestershire and North Somerset.

However, your child (aged 11-16) may be eligible for school travel support if any of the following apply;

- You are on a low income and therefore your child qualifies for free school meals or you are on the maximum level of Working Tax Credit.
- You are in temporary accommodation
- Your child has special educational needs, an Education Health Care Plan (EHC) or a disability
