Transport Arrangements 2023/24

In consultation with the three local authorities that we serve, transport arrangements have put in place which families are required to fund as follows;

Bristol : Three routes operate : Currently £87.50 per month, per child *

BRS01 Stokes Croft, Kings Drive, Kellaway Avenue, Golden Hill, Wellington Hill, Westbury Village
BRS02 Bishopston, Monks Park Avenue, Southmead Road, Doncaster Road, Greystoke Avenue/Brentry
BRS03 Eastgate, Muller Road, Filton Avenue, Lake Road

Please note : First Bus Public Bus Services operate number's 3 and 4 from Broadmead, Clifton, Stoke Bishop, Sea Mills, Shirehampton, Avonmouth, Henbury and Cribbs Causeway.

South Gloucestershire: Two routes operate: Currently £100 per month per child *

SG01 Badminton Road, Bromley Heath, Frenchay, Filton, Patchway, Lysander Road
SG03 Stoke Gifford, Bradley Stoke, Little Stoke, Easter Compton, Pilning, Severn Beach

North Somerset : Two routes operate: Currently £150 per month, per child *

WSM Route N Locking, Drove Road, Milton, Worle
Route P Nailsea, Clevedon, Portishead

Is your child eligible for support with home to school transport?

Free Transport for all children travelling to denominational schools has been withdrawn by the three local authorities that we serve, Bristol, South Gloucestershire and North Somerset.

However, your child (aged 11-16) may be eligible for school travel support if any of the following apply;

- You are on a low income and therefore your child qualifies for free school meals or you are on the maximum level of Working Tax Credit.
- You are in temporary accommodation
- Your child has special educational needs, an Education Health Care Plan (EHC) or a disability
