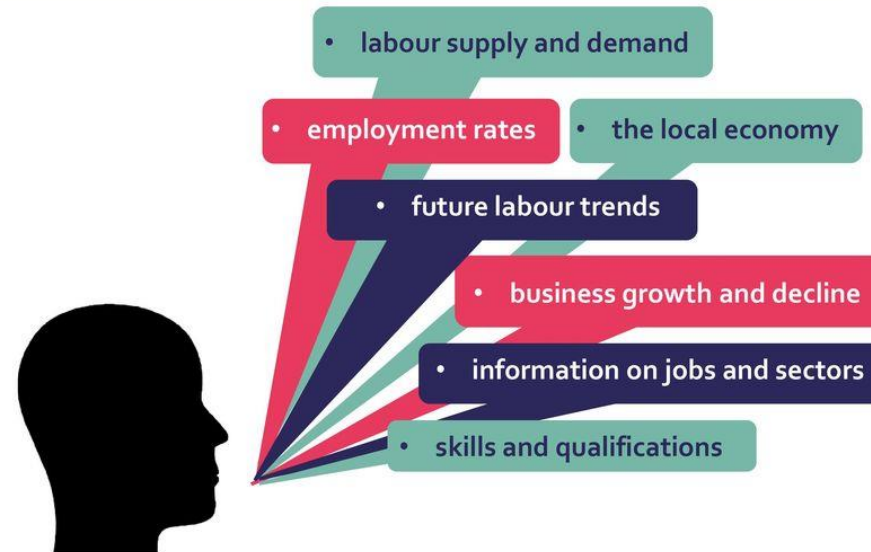


Labour Market Information – What is it?
