Wild Place

All Year 7 students will visit The Wild Place, Cribbs Causeway. Students will have the opportunity to explore the site in small groups and the visit will include an educational session called Wild about Wolves.

Students need to arrive at school on time because they will leave before the end of normal registration. They will be back at school before the end of the school day.

Students need to bring a packed lunch with them. **It is essential that this contains no nuts or products containing nuts. Please check packaging carefully.** If pupils are in receipt of free school

meals, a packed lunch will be provided. Students are allowed to wear their own clothes but they must wear sensible footwear. In the case of hot weather, students will also need to ensure they have a hat and have applied sun screen. In case of rain, they will need a raincoat and appropriate footwear.

Inevitably arranging trips to places off the school site has a cost for transport and for entry fees, where payable. The contribution for each student, for the trips planned, is **£16.00**, unless your child qualifies for pupil premium. Please note that the cost of the trips is being subsidised from College funds, in order to make the contribution as affordable as possible.

Please complete the attached Consent and Payment form, and return it to the Finance Office. **Payment should be made via the on-line payment system, Scopay. If you need support using Scopay, please contact the Finance Office.** Please return the consent form and make payment all by **Friday 7th June**. If you have difficulty with making a payment by then, please complete the forms and enclose an explanatory note.

For the sport session, students should wear their school PE kit.

The Master Class brochure will be distributed in June for students to make their choices. There will be a charge for a small number of Master Classes.

Cadbury World

Students will spend the whole day at Cadbury World. We will leave St Bede's at 8.00am prompt and will return by 3.15pm. The cost is based on 64 pupils travelling. Pedal Progression Mountain Biking Coaching

The trip will run three times on **Monday 8th July, Tuesday 9th July and Friday 12th July**. There are **15 places** available each day - students can only attend once. In the event of more requests to attend the trip than places available, places will be randomly allocated.

Students do not need experience in mountain biking but they **must be able to confidently** ride a bike across grass in order to participate. Students will be provided with bikes and helmets by the coaches at Pedal Progression and have four hours of coaching during the day. If your child wishes to use their own mountain bike and protection, this is allowed. Students will need to bring a packed lunch with them or money to purchase lunch/snacks in the café on site.
